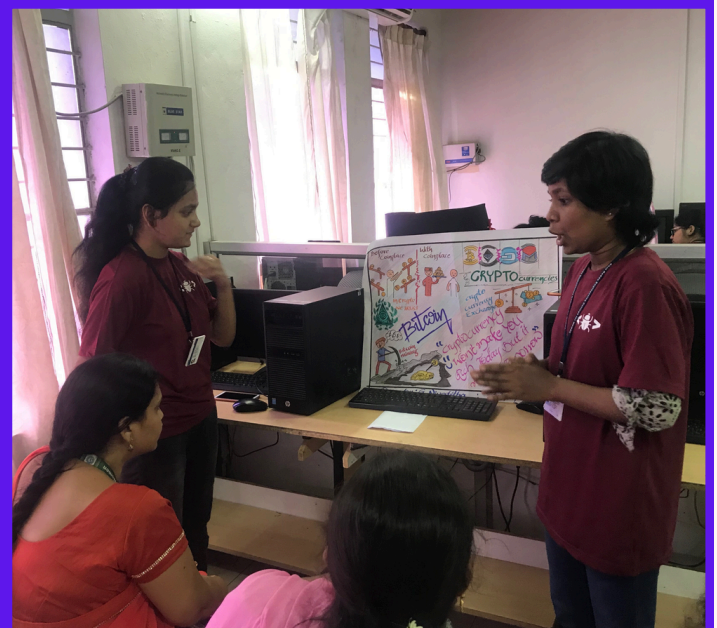

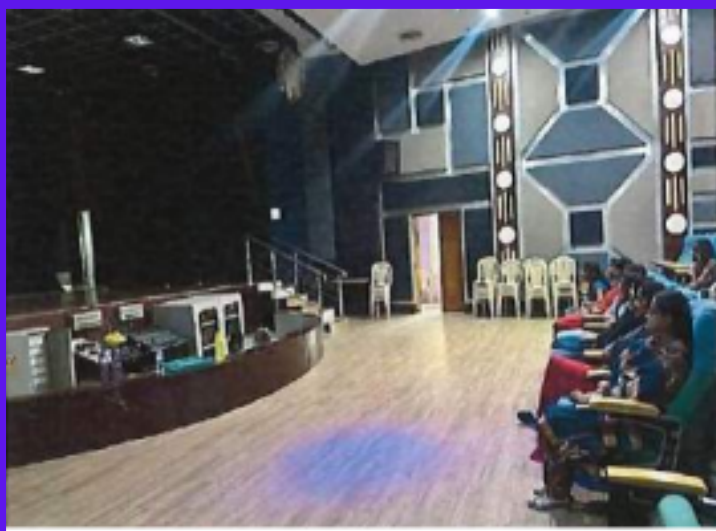


## NSS Activities
