BRECW develops confident and articulate young women into dynamic engineers equipped with skills, knowledge, values and an attitude to contribute to the society.

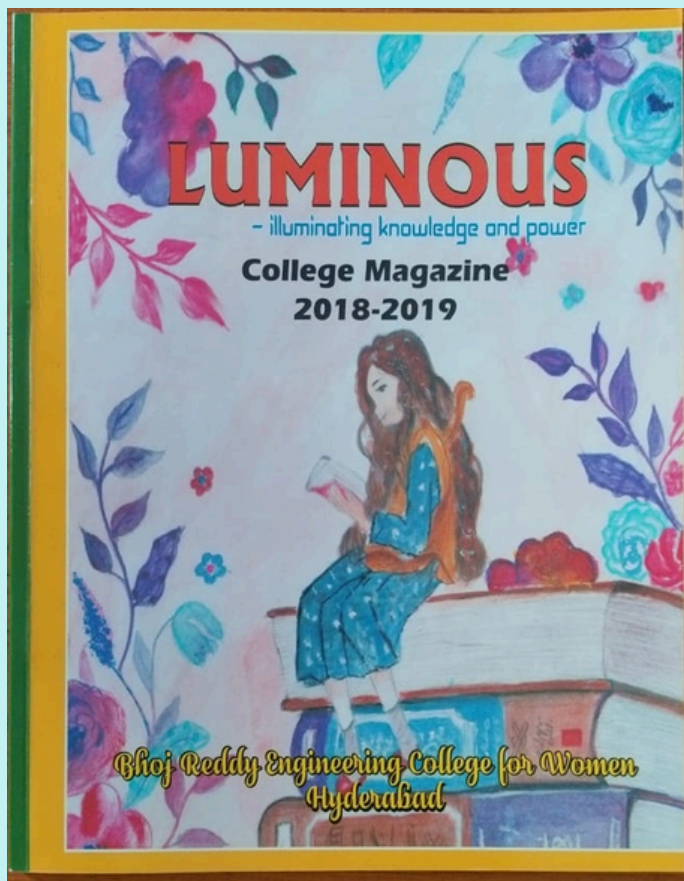
Mission
