Held at the Ramdev Convention Centre from 10:00 AM to 12:30 PM, the session featured K Prasad, Deputy Superintendent at Singareni Thermal Power Plant, Ramagundam, Telangana, as the keynote speaker. Mr. Prasad began by explaining the fundamental principles and operational procedures of thermal power plants, highlighting the critical stages of power generation and emphasizing efficiency and environmental considerations.

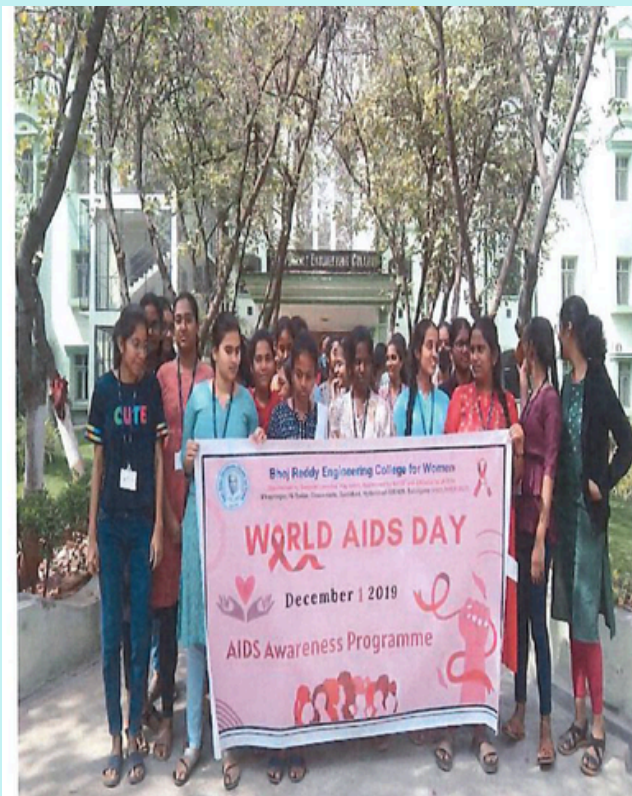
