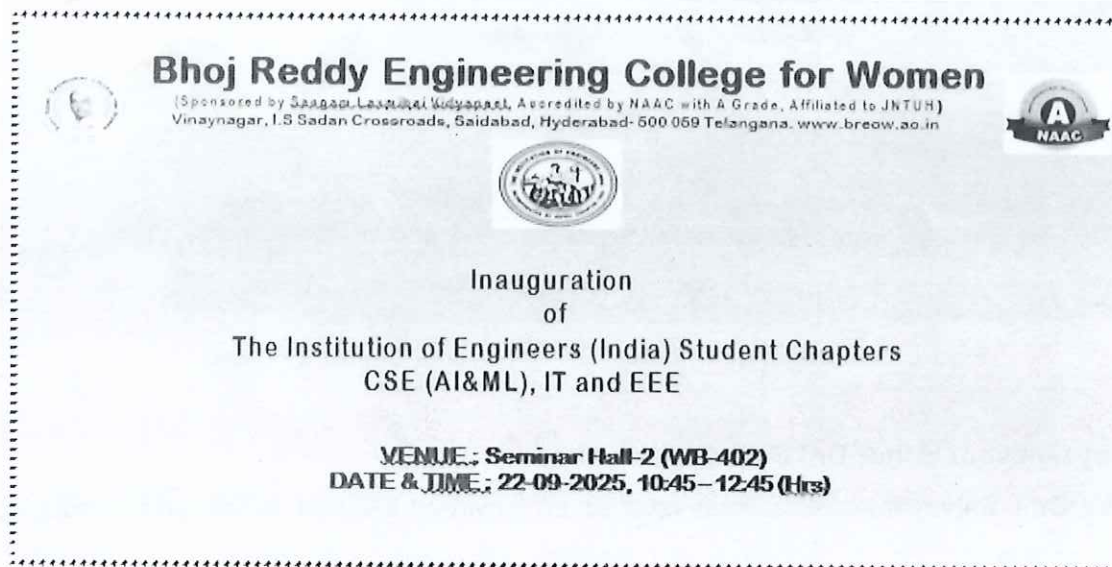


Figure 1: Banner for Inauguration of IEI

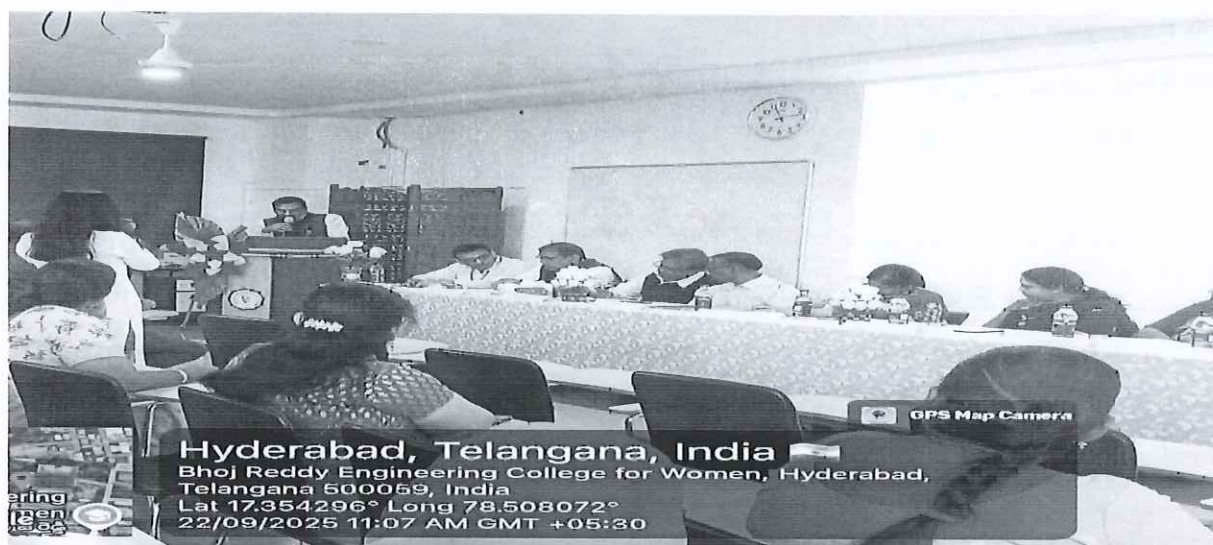

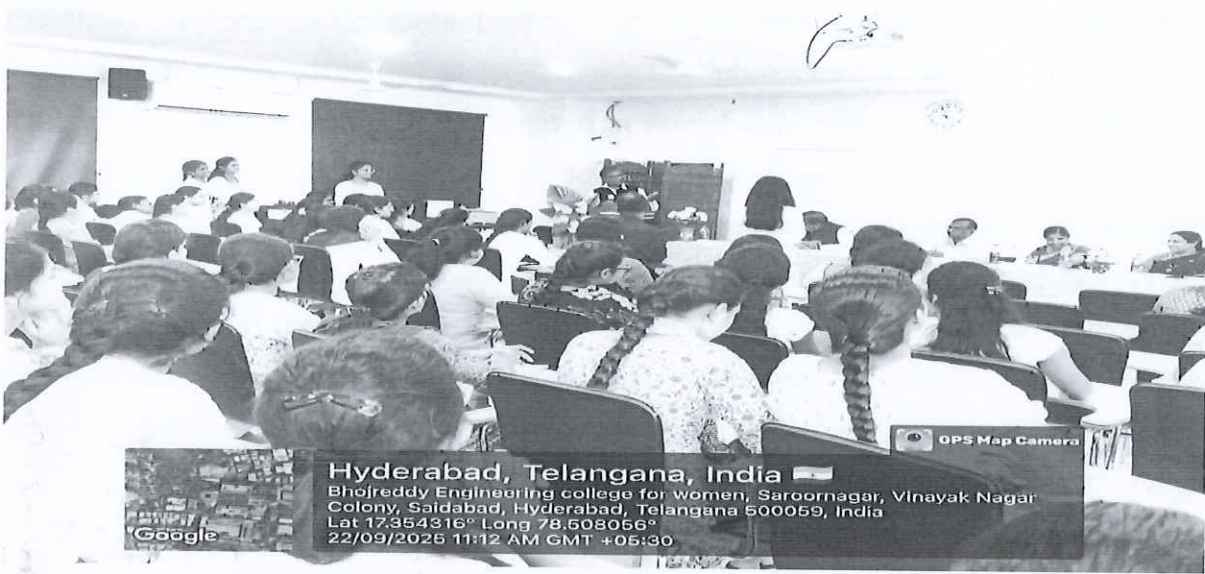


Figure 3: Address by Guest of Honor Dr I Satyayanarayana Raju

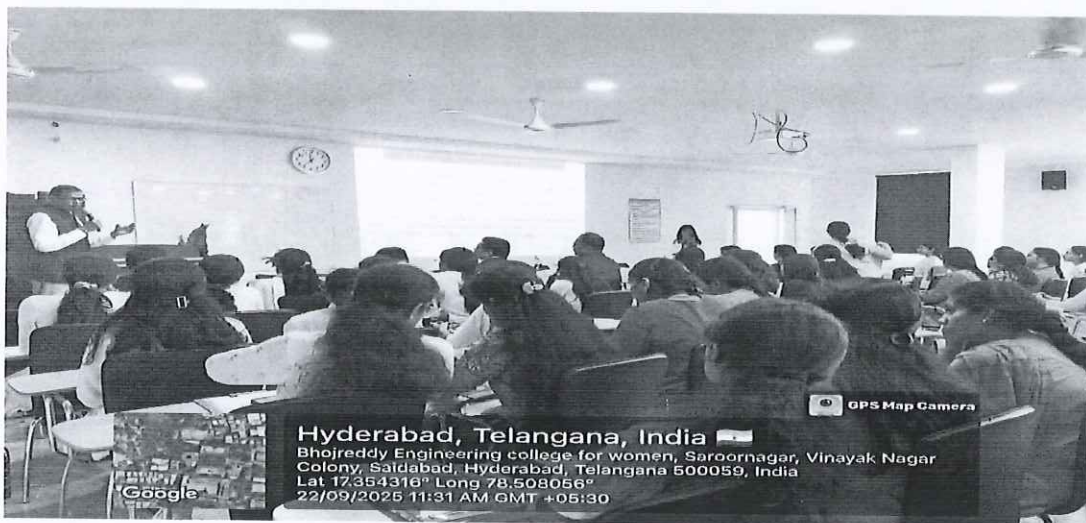


Figure 4: Address by Guest of Honor Dr K. Seetha Ram Babu

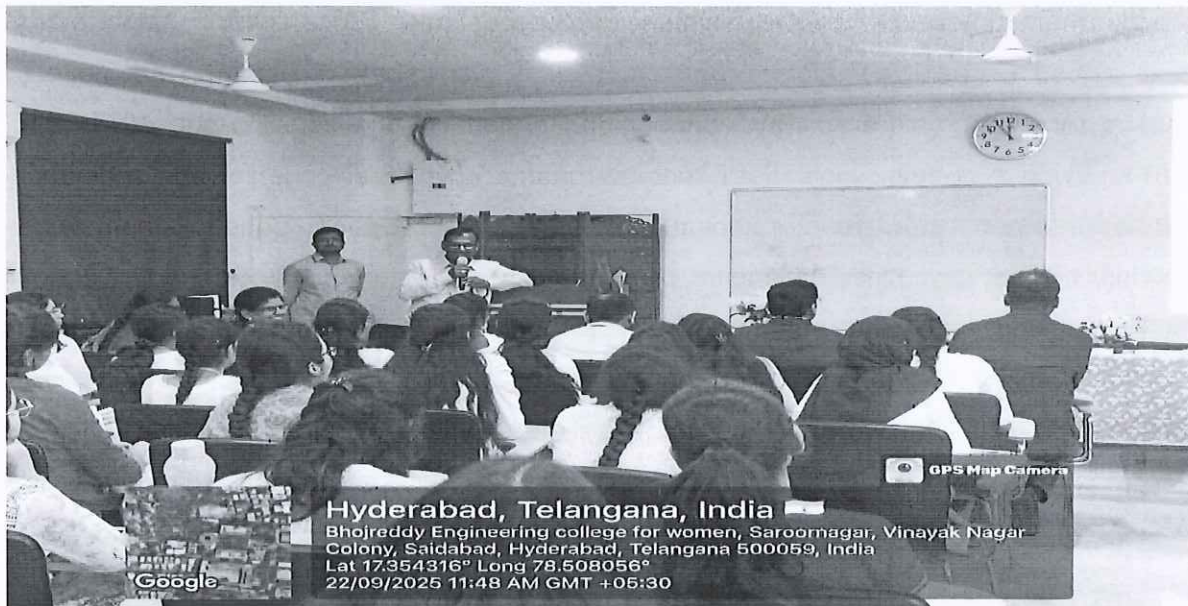


Figure 5: Address by Chief Guest, Er. B Brahma Reddy
